

Taking a Look Into the Future Website Project Worth 100 Points

Scenario

This Web project is going to require you think about what you want your life to be like ten years from now. Think about five different aspects of your life that you feel you would be able to make a Web site out of. This site needs to be a minimum of six pages. You need to create a Web page for each topic you select and your homepage (remember to name this either index or default) needs to be an overview of the five pages that make up your Web site.

Some ideas for pages include, (but is NOT limited to) Where you went to college, where you want to live, what career you want to have, what car you want to drive, and places you want to have traveled to.

Additional Requirements

Like all projects the material contained within each of your Web pages must be school appropriate. This applies to all information included within the project and it must NOT contain anything that might be considered offensive or disrespectful. Projects that do not follow this simple guideline will receive a zero!

References that indicate where you found pictures, information, or other materials should be included on the proper pages. DO NOT copy and paste information from one Website directly into your project. Summarize information, put it into your own words, and make it meaningful to you and your audience.

Don't forget to spell check! You will lose five points for each spelling error found within your project. Also organization counts for this project. Do you have folders for graphics, pages, documents, etc., or do you have a whole bunch of files in your main student folder?

After you have completed your Web project, please turn in your planning sheet stapled to the bottom of this sheet (with your name on it!!).

Remember your planning sheet is worth 10 points.
